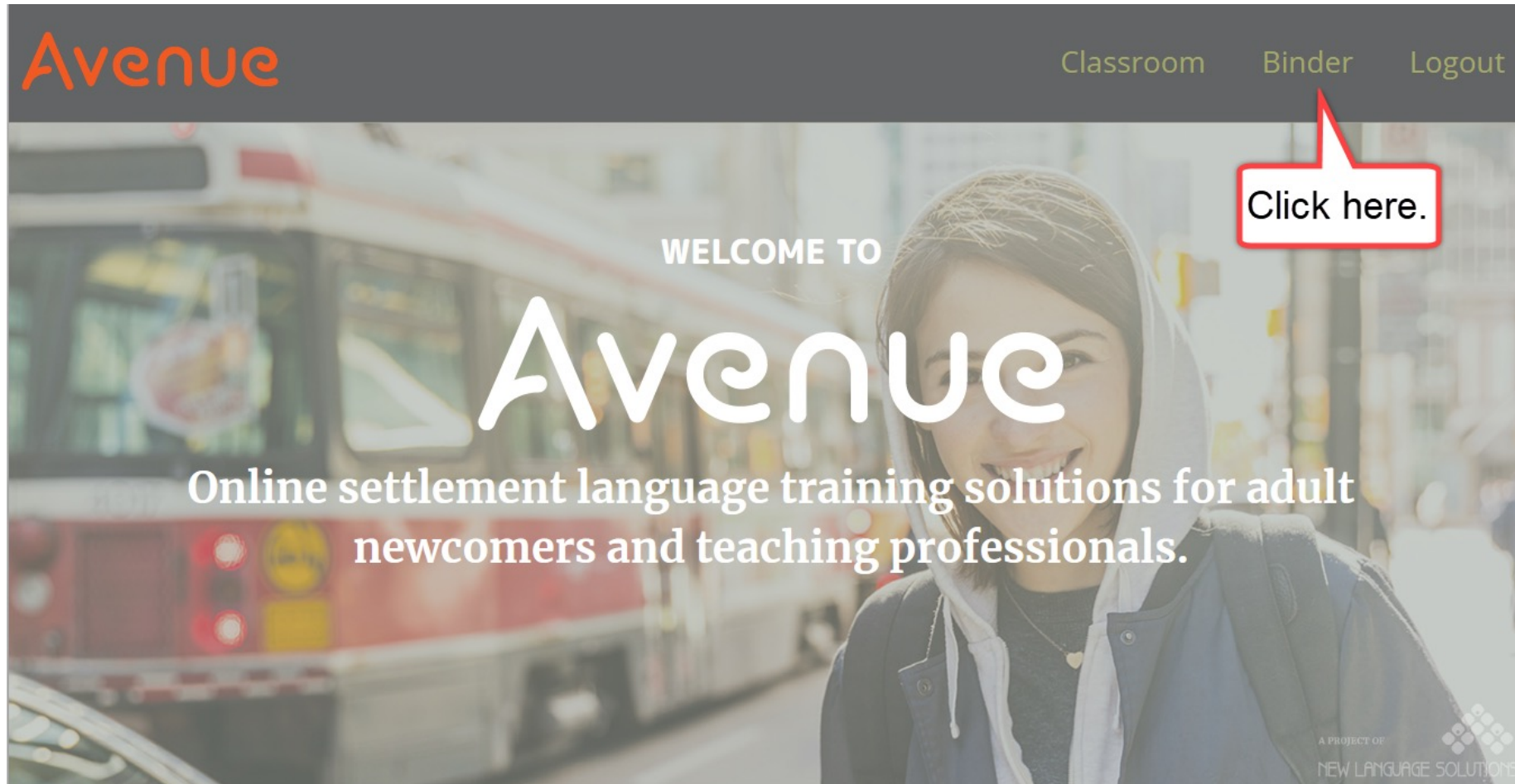

# How to Change your Eportfolio View

# 1. Click on Binder.
